

CUSTOMER SUCCESS STORY: THE PROLIFICS DATA GOVERNANCE WORKSHOP

Our customer is a large property and casualty insurance company that offers business and personal insurance in the upper northeast region of the US.

CHALLENGE

This insurance company has a compliance-driven initiative to improve data lifecycle management, particularly its data retention and destruction policy. While they have the data strategy, framework, and technology to support their governance efforts, their data retention/destruction process is manual and very time-consuming. Additionally, there are no metrics to assess or track compliance efforts.

Through the Prolifics workshop approach, the company asked us to:

- Perform discovery for their data lifecycle management process
- Create a roadmap to accelerate, automate, and track their data retention and destruction processes, incorporating intelligent automation where appropriate

ACTION
